Bite-Size

Thanks to the generosity of Battelle, we have offered the virtual STEAM program, Bite-Size Science for free to 100 central Ohio elementary schools!

Created by zoologist and educator, Lucas Miller, Bite-Size Science enriches students' learning about life science by offering 10-15-minute video lessons, covering topics that include animals' basic needs, habitats and ecosystems, adaptations, photosynthesis, bees and pollination, monarch butterflies, and more.

Each video presents a fun lesson using music, art, and nature footage to engage students with learning about animals and the natural world. The program comes complete with lessons, crafts, and enrichment activities.

Columbus City Schools worked with CAPA to create an episode guide for Science and Music educators. The episode guide connects each episode to the appropriate grade level and Ohio curriculum standards.
